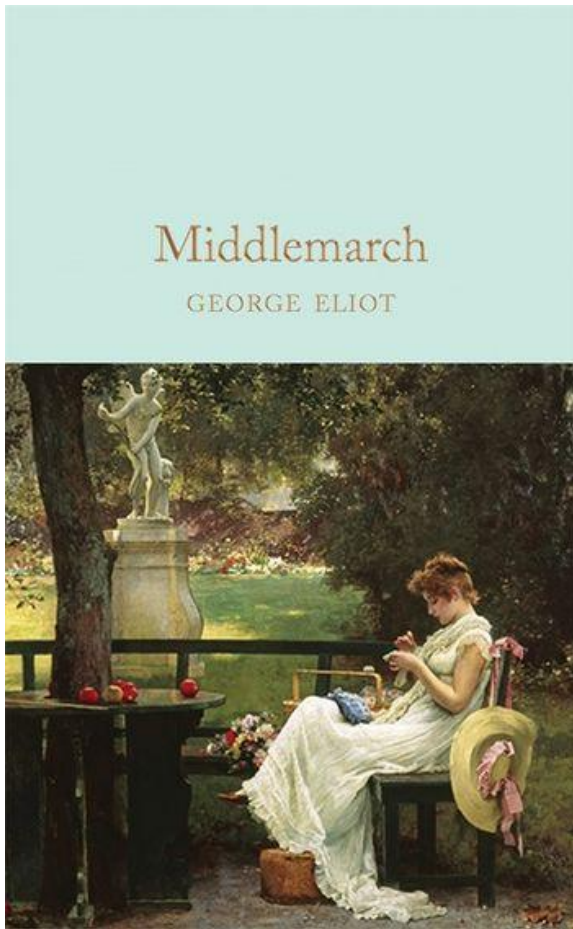

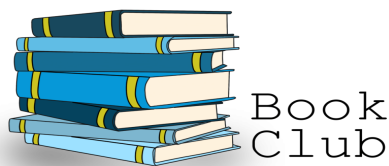


Middlemarch is a novel by George Eliot, pseudonym of Mary Ann Evans. Set just before the First Reform Bill of 1832, *Middlemarch* explores the town, its citizens of every class, and their everyday interconnected lives. We will read portions of the novel for each discussion session.

Discussions will take place on Mondays: 9/12/2022, 10/3/2022, 10/24/2022, and 11/14/2022 at 6pm.

These sessions are free, open to the public, and accessible to those with disabilities.

Books will be available on loan in advance.
